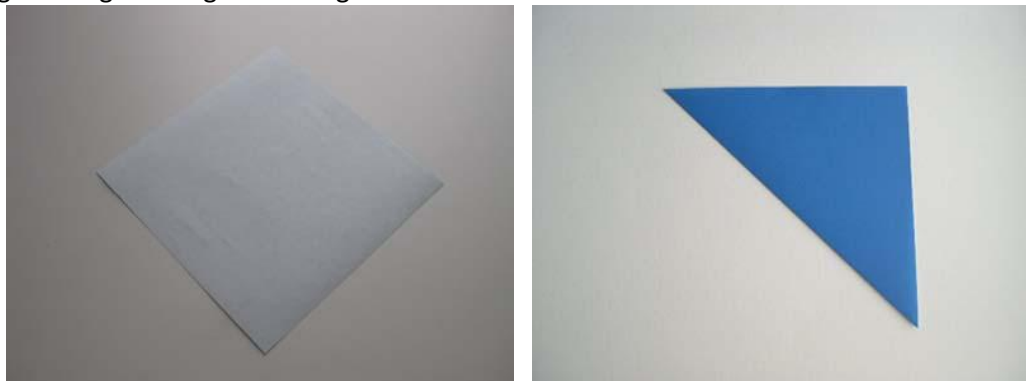
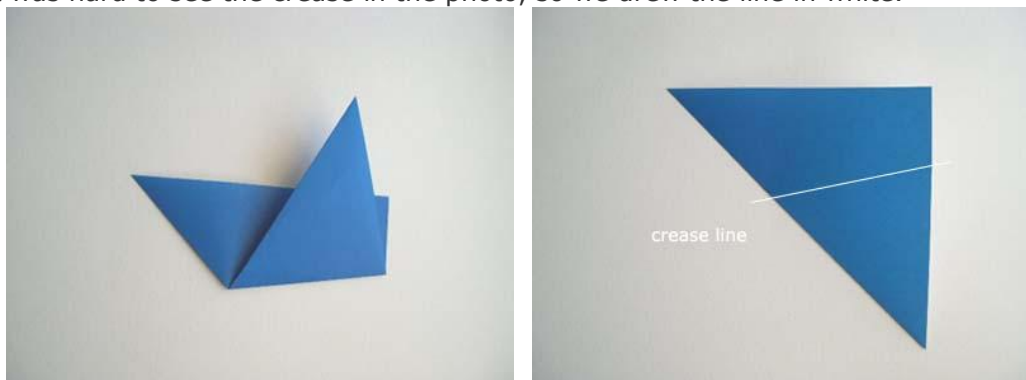


## Make an Origami Boat – Things Found at Castle Loch, Lochmaben

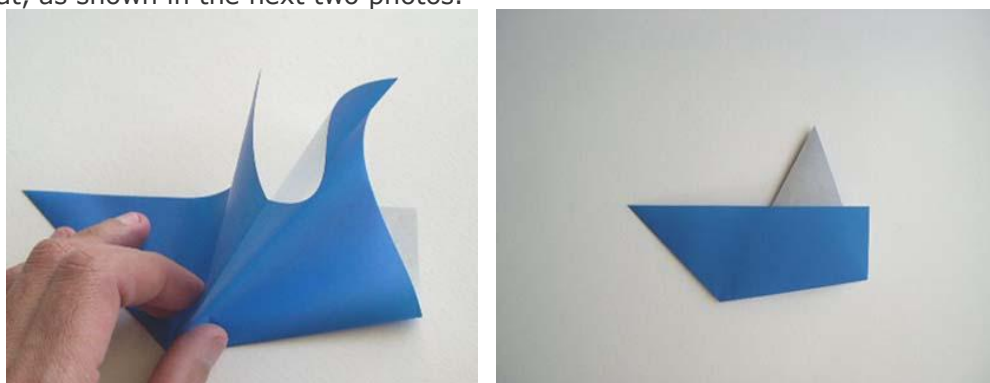
**Easy Origami Boat Step 1:** Start with a square 6" x 6" (15cm x 15cm) origami paper colour side down. Then fold along the diagonal to give a triangle.



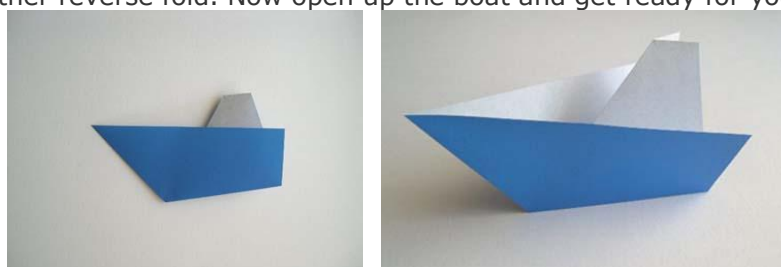
**Easy Origami Boat Step 2:** Now fold one corner of the triangle upwards as shown, then unfold again to form a crease line. It was hard to see the crease in the photo, so we drew the line in white.



**Easy Origami Boat Step 3:** Now do a reverse fold. Take that bottom corner and bring it upwards between the sides of the boat, as shown in the next two photos.



**Easy Origami Boat Step 4:** Now the pointed top of the boat cabin is flattened by cutting or tearing off the top. Or you can do another reverse fold. Now open up the boat and get ready for your ocean voyage!
