Terms & Conditions for participants

- There is a submission fee to raise funds to support Castle Loch: Professional and Amateur artists - £5, 12-16 year olds - £2, Under 12's - Free (donations welcome).
- Only one entry per person.
- Artwork to have been completed at Castle Loch on Saturday, 21st July 2018 - Registration from 9.30am, start 10am, close 3pm.
- Subject of artwork in 2D format of the Castle Loch grounds, any view from the Castle Loch grounds, or item found within the loch grounds.
- Entrants may use traditional media eg oil, pastel, charcoal, graphite, ink, coloured pencil, water colour, gouache, acrylic etc. No digital submissions accepted.
- Surfaces, such as, paper, canvas, board are to be supplied by the entrant.
- Size: No larger than A3 (297 × 420mm)
- The final submission can be mounted by the entrant but not framed.
- All surfaces must be presented for stamping/labelling at Lochfield Cottage from 9.30am on the day of the competition.
- Entrants are responsible for delivery and collection of their work.
- Entries will be judged by a panel of professional and local artists by 4pm on the day of competition. The judges decision is final.
- Winners and Highly Commended are obliged to exhibit at Lochfield Cottage for 1 month after the competition and to agree to the use of the picture for reproduction on social media and possible future calendar / postcard.
- Winners: 1st prize and Highly Commended will be awarded in each category.
- Photography will occur during the event and be used in the local press and on social media.
- Data Protection: Please note that all application details and visuals will be stored in our database and used for processing applications and for printed/online publicity purposes. This information will not be given to any third party and will only be used by CLLCT.

Castle Loch Art Competition – Participation Guidelines

Submissions: Saturday, 21st July 2018, 10am to 3pm (registration from 9.30am)

All artwork is to be carried out on the above date in the grounds of Castle Loch. All surfaces must be presented for stamping/labelling at Lochfield Cottage on the day of the competition. The finished work is to be submitted at Lochfield Cottage at 3pm, for judging by 4pm the same day.

Entry Fee


There is a submission fee to raise funds to support Castle Loch:

- Professional and Amateur artists - £5
- 12-16 year olds - £2
- Under 12's - Free (donations welcome).

Judging

Three independent judges will select work and award prizes. Their decision is final.

Entry guidelines (see the registration form for full T&Cs)

- The competition is open to all artists, professional and amateur, submitting work showing what is special about Castle Loch.
 - The subject is to be of the Castle Loch grounds, any view from the Castle Loch grounds, or any item found within the loch grounds.
 - All submitted artwork must be original works of art and carried out on the 21st July 2018 in the grounds of Castle Loch.
 - Artists may submit one piece of 2D artwork in any medium except photographic prints.
 - 2D work should be no larger than A3.
 - All surfaces must be presented for stamping/labelling at Lochfield Cottage from 9.30am on the day of the competition.

Castle Loch Art Competition Participation Guidelines - cont'd

Location and Parking:

Castle Loch is located on the edge of the Royal Burgh of Lochmaben. There are car parks and lay-bys around the site. Lochfield Cottage is located next to the loch side car park on the A709 Lockerbie to Lochmaben road. Please note parking is limited at the Cottage and it is advisable to use this location for drop off and collection only. The cottage is 10 minutes walk from Lochmaben.
