

Castle Loch, Lochmaben Fishing Permits

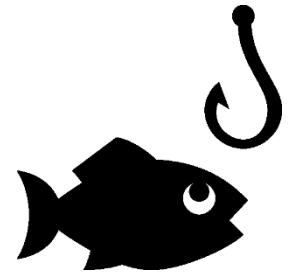
Pricing per day:

Residents: FREE (Templand, Lochmaben and The Royal Four Towns)

Adult: £11.00 (2 rods), £15.00 (3 rods)

Concession: £5.00 (<16, OAP, Disabled)

Available from Pettigrew's on Lochmaben High Street or online



Fishing Rules:

- Fishers do so at their own risk and permits are not transferable
- Permits to be exhibited together with tackle when requested to do so by police, bailiffs, staff or representatives of Castle Loch Lochmaben Community Trust (CLLCT)
- Maximum of three rods to be used per swim
- Keep nets are prohibited
- All fish to be returned to the loch alive
- Boats: no outboard motors to be used

General Rules:

- Avoid fishing in the loch sanctuary area
- No disturbance of wildlife or breaking of reeds and vegetation
- Take all litter home
- No fires or camping - overnight fishing is permitted from a shelter
- Dogs to be kept under strict control
- No firearms

Where to fish:

Fishing piers are available along the main A709 (park in main car park) and at various spots along the Lochmaben to Dalton B7020 road (park in the numerous roadside laybys). There are also open bankside areas near Lochmaben Castle and off to the right of the main car park on the A709.

Please note fishing bailiffs operate around the loch
